



Supply List—Grade 3

Dear 3rd Grade Families,

Welcome to 3rd Grade at Grace Classical Academy! We look forward to getting to know each of you and your children. One of the many important skills your child will learn will be developing good work habits. To help your child practice these skills, we ask that you purchase his/her school supplies through our special program. Mrs. Phillips will personally purchase all of the supplies your child will need to begin school. The cost of the supply kits will be approximately \$35 and will be paid to Mrs. Phillips during the first week of school. To understand how helpful this program will be for your child, please read the following rationale:

- Classroom procedures are more efficient if we can give specific directions when preparing for a class activity. For example, Mrs. Phillips can say "take out your Spelling Folder", and everyone knows exactly what to get. They don't need to remember which folder they picked for Spelling.
- One folder is always the Homework Folder. This goes home daily and has to be returned daily. Having one color makes it much easier for the child to remember and us to identify.
- With all children having the same supplies, there is no opportunity for comparison or discontent.
- Storage space is sufficient but limited. By having the same supplies, we are able to help the students learn personal time and space management.

If needed, additional items will be noted in your child's Classroom Newsletter after school starts.

You will still need to purchase the following items and bring them on the first day of school:

- Backpack
- Lunchbox
- Water bottle (please label with your child's name) (if you have one from last year, you may use it)
- 1 New International Version (NIV) Bible
- 1 small pencil sharpener (Get something cool and fun if you like!)
- 1 FLAT ruler (Get something cool and fun if you like!)
- 2 cloth face masks, any solid color
- 2 containers of antibacterial cleaning wipes (EPA-approved for coronavirus)
- 2 cans of disinfecting spray (such as Lysol, EPA-approved for coronavirus)
- 3 personal-sized containers of gel hand sanitizer (no sprays; one will be used for music totes)
- 2 small Command Hooks (to attach masks and face shields to desks)
- 2 boxes of tissues
- For Art - Crayola washable markers and a clear 12 inch plastic ruler
- For Music:
 - Tote with handles to carry items to music class (label with CHILD'S NAME AND "MUSIC")
 - One Soprano Recorder (Baroque/English)
 - One 3-ring binder (Size 1 1/2 inches)
 - Three Paper binder dividers with tabs: Tab 1: label "Recorder", Tab 2: label "Theory", Tab 3: label "Composers/Instrumentation"
 - 1 pack of crayons
 - 1 pack of colored pencils
 - Regular pencils (2 of them)
 - One eraser
