



Supply List—Grades 9-12

All Students in 9th through 12th Grades:

- Pencils (#2, sharpened)
- Pens (black or blue, and red)
- Highlighter(s)
- College-ruled paper (3 packs)
- 12-inch ruler
- Scissors
- Book covers (for Algebra, History, Science, and French)
- 12 or 24 pack of fine/ultrafine multicolor Sharpies (for Art)
- 1 white Pentel Hi-Polymer Eraser (for Art)
- Backpack
- Lunchbox
- Water bottle
- Planner
- English Standard Version (ESV) Bible
- 2 cloth facemasks, solid colors, designed to fit closely over the nose
- 2 personal-sized containers of gel hand sanitizer (no sprays)
- 2 small *Command Hooks* (to attach masks and face shields to desks)
- 2 boxes of tissues (for classrooms)
- 2 packages of antibacterial cleaning wipes (for lunch tables, EPA-approved for coronavirus)
- 2 can of disinfecting spray (such as Lysol, EPA-approved for coronavirus)

- 3" x 5" index cards – 2 packs of 100 (for French and English)
- 1 1 ½" Binder (for French)
- Calculator (can be scientific, not graphing)

Students in 11th Grade should also purchase:

- 11 three-prong pocket folders - paper or plastic (for History and English)
- 2 spiral notebooks (100 pages or more with a folder inside)
- 1 pack of Post-it Page Markers (for English)
- 3 ultrafine Sharpie markers not pens (for History; at least 3 colors; no light/pastel colors)

Students in 12th Grade should also purchase:

- 2 Spiral Notebooks (100 pages or more with a folder inside)
